Camp Descriptions

Daycare Camp (ages: 2.5 - 4 years)

Offered @: NF, STC

The Boys and Girls Club Niagara Falls Centre, Kids First Childcare Centre is pleased to offer award winning high quality childcare, recognized by the Prime Minister of Canada. Curriculum encourages school readiness, fun physical activity, and enriched personal development in a warm, caring and happy environment. The daycare camp experience includes trips, nutritious hot meal and snacks, and swimming.

Jr. Adventure Camp (ages: 5 - 6 years)

Offered @: NF, STC

Jr. Adventure Campers enjoy almost all the same activities as the big kids do, but keeping in mind their developmental and physical needs. The weeks are theme-based, with indoor and outdoor traditional camp activities, swimming, special guests and one trip per week. Your Jr. Adventurer will build confidence and learn new skills and make new friends. The use a smaller staff to child ratios (1:10) ensures safety and to also ensure their first true camp experience is a positive one.

Adventure Camp (ages: 7 - 12 years)

Offered @: FE, NF, NOTL, P/W, PC, STC

Adventure Camp provides one wonderful week after another. The Boys and Girls Club staff build new skills and also self-confidence in a fun environment. The weeks are theme-based, with indoor and outdoor traditional camp activities, swimming, special guests and one trip per week. Also each week includes a special event day!

Sports Camp (ages: 9 - 12 years)

Offered @: NF

Sports Camp will encourage campers to develop skills and their appreciation for sports. The campers' program will emphasize on sport appreciation, skill development, sportsmanship and team building. The camps will also participate in traditional camp activities as well. The weeks are theme-based, with indoor and outdoor sports and games, swimming, special guests and one trip per week. Campers will be involved in high levels of activity throughout the week.

Leaders in Training (ages: 13-16 years)

Offered @: NF, STC

This 2 week program involves skill and leadership development with a senior camp staff, followed by optional weeks of emersion in a camp group. The LITs will learn valuable tools such as leadership and supervision in a camp setting, camp planning, healthy childhood development strategies, and much, much more. The campers will also be trained and certified in Emergency First Aid and CPR.

Camp Hours 7:00am - 6:00pm

The Boys and Girls Club of Niagara will be introducing Camp Hours for Working Families (7am-6pm). The extended hours provide the opportunity for families to drop-off and pick-up their child(ren) when it is convenient to them.

The bus transportation route is a set schedule and bus pick-up/drop-off times cannot be modified, and times will be determined by each individual site offering transportation.

Evening Care is also available at the Niagara Falls site 6pm-10pm. Please contact the Niagara Falls Centre for details.
